IsaGenix Cleanse: The true Story Behind The Diet

Natural Accelerator is a capsule-form supplement meant to clean the body and provide better energy release without side-effects. Those are the components common to both IsaGenix Cleanse programs.

The 30 Day program includes, additionally to those components previously mentioned, Ionix Supreme, IsaFlush, Want More Energy?, and IsaDelight. Ionix Supreme is basically a power-modifying drink, made to enhance stress-coping and improve energy release. IsaFlush is a mix of five cleansing herbs, which is designed to make you stay regular in the toilet. "Want More Energy?" is a set of rehydration drinks included in a convenient stick form – just tear, pour into water, and shake. IsaDelight is a nutritionally-controlled chocolate drink; an "indulgence" without the guilt. That wraps it up for the components of the IsaGenix Cleanse systems. Of course, both programs have a guidebook and an informational DVD.

The easiest way to look at this would be to consider the reduction in calories and non-essential substances. By undergoing these programs, you reduce your caloric intake to less than three-fourths of your daily recommended allowance, in some cases as low as 50 percent of the recommended 2000 calories daily.
